SHEEP SCAB MOVEMENT AREAS.

The following Areas are now "Movement Areas" for the purposes of Part II of the Sheep Scab Order of 1928:—

1. Inverness.—An Area comprising the islands known as the Outer Hebrides (except the Islands of St. Kilda, Dune, Soay and Boreray), in the county of Inverness.

2. Ross and Cromarty.—An Area comprising the island of Lewis, including the smaller islands adjacent thereto, in the county of Ross and Cromarty.
