

them by the Agricultural Wages (Regulation) Act, 1924, and the Regulations made thereunder do by this Order vary as from 24th August, 1931, their Order of 16th September, 1930, defining the employment which is to be treated as overtime employment for the purpose of the application of any differential rate of wages for overtime employment fixed by the said Committee for the area comprising the administrative county of Salop, so as to provide that such employment shall be as follows:—

1. In the case of male workers:—

(a) All employment on a Sunday, Christmas Day and Good Friday.

(b) All employment after 1 p.m. on a Saturday or on such other weekday as may be agreed between the employer and worker as the weekly short day.

(c) In the weeks in which Christmas Day falls in 1931 and 1932, all employment in excess of 44½ hours (excluding all hours which are treated as hours of overtime employment).

(d) In the week in which Good Friday falls in 1932, all employment in excess of 44½ hours (excluding all hours which are treated as hours of overtime employment).

(e) In any other week, all employment in excess of 54 hours (excluding all hours which are treated as hours of overtime employment).

2. In the case of female workers:—

All employment on a Sunday, Christmas Day and Good Friday.

Witham and Steeping Rivers Catchment Board.
