ELECTRICITY (SUPPLY) ACTS,
1882 TO 1928.LONDON AND HOME COUNTIES ELECTRICITY
DISTRICT ORDER, 1925.

*Joint Authority: Representatives of workers
in the Industry.*

The Minister of Labour hereby gives notice that as soon as may be after the 17th day of September, 1931, she will designate to the London and Home Counties Joint Electricity Authority, in accordance with Section 2 (10) of Part I of the First Annex to the Schedule to the London and Home Counties Electricity District Order, 1925, the employees' organisations having members in the employment of authorised undertakers in the District, in order that the organisations so designated may choose two representatives of persons employed in connection with the supply of electricity in the District to be members of the Joint Authority.

Any employees' organisation which is desirous of being considered by the Minister for designation under the said Section 2 (10) should make application in writing to the Minister not later than the 17th day of Septem-

ber, 1931, on the form provided for the purpose, of which copies may be obtained from the Secretary, Ministry of Labour, Montagu House, Whitehall, London, S.W. 1.
