"II. And also all those contiguous portions of the said Parish of Dudley and of the said New Parish of Saint Edmund, Dudley, which, taken together, are bounded upon the east by the said New Parish of Saint John, Kate's Hill, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the south west and upon the north west, by an imaginary line commencing at the point where the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint John, Kate's Hill, from the said Parish of Dudley crosses the middle of Lloyd Street, and extending thence north westward along the middle of Lloyd Street for a distance of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to its junction with Shedden Street, and extending thence north eastward along the middle of Shedden Street for a distance of  $3\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to its junction with Blackacre Road, and extending thence north westward along the middle of Blackacre Road (thereby crossing the boundary which divides the said Parish of Dudley from the said New Parish of Saint Edmund, Dudley) for a distance of  $3\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to its junction with the road called Constitution Hill and with Oakeywell Street and extending thence north westward along the middle of Oakeywell Street for a distance of 3 chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to the middle of the roadway leading into the road called Waddam's Pool, and extending thence north eastward to and along the middle of such roadway for a distance of 6 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Edmund, Dudley, from the said New Parish of Saint John, Kate's Hill.

"III. And also all that portion of the said New Parish of Saint Andrew, Netherton, which is bounded upon the east by the Parish of Rowley Regis, in the said County of Stafford and in the Diocese of Birmingham, upon the north by the said New Parish of Saint John, Kate's Hill, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the west and upon the south west, by an imaginary line commencing at the point where the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint John, Kate's Hill, from the said New Parish of Saint Andrew, Netherton, crosses the middle of Baptistend Road, and extending thence southward along the middle of Baptistend Road for a distance of 2 chains or thereabouts to the centre of the bridge which carries the said Netherton and Halesowen Line of the Great Western Railway across such road, and extending thence south eastward along the middle of the said line of railway for a distance of  $42\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Andrew, Netherton, from the said Parish of Rowley Regis.

*"The Fifth Schedule.*

"The territory to be dissevered from the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Dudley, and to be annexed to the said New Parish of Saint Andrew, Netherton, being:—

"All that portion of the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Dudley, which is bounded upon the south by the said New Parish of Saint Andrew, Netherton, and upon the remaining

sides, that is to say, upon the north west and upon the east, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Andrew, Netherton, from the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Dudley, at the centre of the viaduct which carries the said Oxford Worcester and Wolverhampton Line of the Great Western Railway across the branch of the Dudley Canal which leads to the Netherton Iron Works, and extending thence north eastward along the middle of the said line of railway (thereby following in part the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Dudley, from the said Parish of Dudley) for a distance of 52 chains or thereabouts to its junction with the said Netherton and Halesowen Line of the same railway, and extending thence first southward and then south eastward along the middle of the last mentioned line of railway for a distance of 36 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Dudley, from the said New Parish of Saint Andrew, Netherton.

*"The Sixth Schedule.*

"The territory to be annexed to the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Dudley, comprising:—

"I. All that portion of the said New Parish of Saint James, Eve Hill, which is bounded upon the south east and upon the south by the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Dudley, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the west, upon the north west, and upon the north east, by an imaginary line commencing at the point where the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Dudley, from the said New Parish of Saint James, Eve Hill, crosses the middle of Wellington Road, and extending thence north eastward along the middle of Wellington Road for a distance of 18 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Stafford Street, and extending thence south eastward along the middle of Stafford Street, for a distance of 4 chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint James, Eve Hill, from the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Dudley.

And also all those contiguous portions of the said New Parish of Saint Andrew, Netherton, and of the New Parish of Saint Augustine, Holly Hall, Dudley, in the said County of Worcester and in the said Diocese of Worcester, which taken together are bounded upon the north west and upon the north east by the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Dudley, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the south east and upon the south west, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Luke, Dudley, from the said New Parish of Saint Andrew, Netherton, at the centre of the viaduct which carries the said Oxford Worcester and Wolverhampton Line of the Great Western Railway across the branch of the Dudley Canal which leads to the Netherton Iron Works, and extending thence south westward along the middle of such line of railway (thereby crossing the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Andrew, Netherton, from the said New Parish of Saint Augustine, Holly Hall, Dudley) for
