

(b) By vessels working in pairs or groups:

A black ball at the foremast head, and a similar ball at the yard-arm, or where it can best be seen, on that side on which it is dangerous to pass.

Vessels should not pass within a distance of 400 yards astern of a pair or group of sweepers, or when more than one pair or group are working in company within a distance of 400 yards astern of the rear pair or group. They should on no account attempt to pass between pairs or groups working in company.

## 2. SIGNALS SHOWN BY NIGHT.

As for day, except that all round *green* lights will be used in a similar manner to and in place of the black balls.

responsible and duly authorised person on his behalf, and must state the specific grounds of objection to the Order and the modifications desired.

A copy of the Order as submitted for confirmation has been deposited for public inspection with the Clerks of the Peace for the Counties of Leicester, Rutland, Northampton, and the Soke of Peterborough, at their Offices at Leicester, Oakham, Northampton and Peterborough respectively; and with the Clerks to the Rural District Councils of Belvoir, Hallaton, Barrow-on-Soar, Billesdon, Loughborough, Market Harborough, Melton Mowbray, Ketton, Uppingham, Oakham, Barnack, Easton-on-the-Hill, Gretton, Kettering, Oundle, Oxenden, and Peterborough, at their respective Offices.

CROYDON CORPORATION ELECTRIC LIGHTING  
ORDER, 1891.
