RESERVOIRS (SAFETY PROVISIONS) ACT, 1930.

PANELS OF QUALIFIED CIVIL ENGINEERS.

(Previous appointments gazetted on 6th February, 13th March, 22nd May, and 25th September, 1931.)

The Secretary of State, acting in conjunction with the Minister of Health, and after consultation with the President of the Institution of Civil Engineers, has appointed Bernard William Bryan (Address:—South Essex Water Works Offices, Romford) to be a member of the Panel of Civil Engineers constituted under the Reservoirs (Safety Provisions) Act, 1930, for the purpose of designing and supervising the construction or alteration of large reservoirs and for the purpose of acting as referee in cases under section 2 (8) of the Act, and also to be a member of the panel of civil engineers constituted under the said Act for the purpose of making inspections and reports under section 2 of the Act.

The Home Secretary gives notice that in pursuance of Section 2 (1) of the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, 1920, he has made an Order authorising the employment on two day-shifts, of women of 18 and young persons of 16 years of age and over in the Cycle Cover, Cycle Wire, and

Cycle Valve Departments at the works of the Dunlop Rubber Company Limited, Fort Dunlop, Erdington, Birmingham, subject to the conditions that a worker shall not be employed in the afternoon shift in consecutive weeks and that suitable cloakroom and mess-room accommodation and washing facilities shall be provided; and that the Secretary of State may at any time require the occupiers to make such special arrangements for the conveyance of workers living at a distance or otherwise for the welfare of such workers as may be necessary to prevent hardship.
