RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport after the expiry of at least forty days from this date in pursuance of the power conferred upon him by the Road Traffic Act, 1930, to make Regulations amending Regulations 2, 3, 12, 13, 29, 30 and 42 of the Public Service Vehicles (Conditions of Fitness) Provisional Regulations, 1931.

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency the Minister of Transport has under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made The Public Service Vehicles (Conditions of Fitness) (Amendment) (No. 2) Provisional Regulations, 1932, to come into force forthwith as Provisional Regulations and to continue in force until Statutory Rules have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.
