LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

River Cuckmere Catchment Board.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has settled and made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming a scheme submitted to him by the River Cuckmere Catchment Board under Section 4 (1) (b) of the Act, making provision for the abrogation of the powers of the Pevensey Levels Commissioners of Sewers, and the constitution of a new Internal Drainage District; and that the Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament, unless within thirty days from the date of this Notice a Memorial that the Order shall not become law without confirmation by Parliament is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected by the Order, and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a Memorial.
