

washing facilities and facilities for sitting shall be provided; that a first aid box or cupboard of the prescribed standard shall be provided and maintained and shall be placed under the charge of a responsible person in each shift; and that the Secretary of State may at any time require the occupiers to make such special

arrangements for the conveyance of workers living at a distance or otherwise for the welfare of such workers as may be necessary to prevent hardship.
