GAS REGULATION ACT, 1920.

THE PICKERING GAS (CHARGES) ORDER, 1932,
 DATED 27TH MAY, 1932.

(Notice in pursuance of Section 3 (1) of the said Order.)

NOTICE is hereby given that the declared calorific value of the Gas which the Company intend to supply shall be 500 British Thermal Units per cubic foot and the date from which the Company will supply Gas of the above value is from the 1st day of January, 1933.

MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT.
 MIDDLESEX COUNTY COUNCIL.
 ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

WHEREAS in pursuance of Section 46 (1) of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, the Council of the County of Middlesex have made application to the Minister of Transport for an

Order to be made by him, the effect of which is:—

To prohibit or restrict, subject to such exceptions or conditions as to occasional user or otherwise as may be specified in the Order, the driving of heavy and light locomotives, motor tractors and heavy motor cars (as defined respectively by Section 2 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930) on Thames Street and Lower Hampton Road between Halliford Road and the Reservoir, in the Urban District of Sunbury.

Provided that nothing in the Order shall prevent the driving upon the said roads of

(i) any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of goods or merchandise to or from any house, building or other premises situate on or adjacent to the said roads.

(ii) any vehicle which is being used in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said roads or the laying, alteration or repair in or near to the said roads of any sewer or of any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or any telegraph or telephone wires, cables, posts or supports.

Notice is hereby given that W. C. Clemens, Esq., A.M.Inst.C.E., one of the Inspectors of the Ministry of Transport, will attend at the Council Offices of the Urban District of Sunbury, "Benwell," Green Street, Sunbury-on-Thames, on Wednesday, the twenty-first day of September, 1932, at 11 o'clock in the forenoon, to hold an Inquiry into the subject matter of the application.

And notice is hereby further given that all persons interested who, within one week from the tenth day of September next, send notice in writing of their desire to be heard at the Inquiry to the Minister of Transport, 7, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W.1, shall be entitled to appear and be heard either in person or by Counsel, Agent or Solicitor.
