TITHE ACT, 1891.

Notice is hereby given in accordance with Section 1 (1) of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that after the expiration of at least 40 days from the date hereof the Lord Chancellor, after consultation with the Rule Committee of County Court Judges, proposes to make Rules under Section 3 of the Tithe Act, 1891, amending the Tithe Rent Charge Recovery Rules, 1891, with respect to:—

(a) Notice appearing on the notice of application for an Order for recovery that, if opposition is not made, an Order may be made and enforced without further notice.

(b) The service on the respondent of a copy of any Order for recovery made by a County Court.

(c) An amendment of Form 2 in the Appendix to the Tithe Rent Charge Recovery Rules, 1891.

BANKRUPTCY ACT, 1914.
