MINISTRY OF TRANSPORT.

IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport, after the expiration of at least forty days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 7 of the aforesaid London Traffic Act to make Regulations amending the London Traffic (Restricted Streets) Regulations.

And notice is hereby further given that, on account of urgency, the Minister has under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made the London Traffic (Restricted Streets) Amendment (Routes Nos. 41B and 176) Provisional Regulations, 1932, to come into operation forthwith as Provisional Regulations, to continue in force until Regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.

These Regulations provide for the re-arrangement of the omnibus services on routes Nos. 41B (Crouch End Broadway and Tottenham Hale) and 176 (Crouch End Broadway and Victoria).
