*Rother and Jury's Gut Catchment Area.*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under Section 4 (3) of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, proposes to make an Order confirming a scheme submitted to him by the Rother and Jury's Gut Catchment Board under Section 4 (1) (b) of the Act, making provision for the abolition of the Commissioners of Sewers for Walland Marsh and Elderton's Innings and the East Guldeford Levels, the Kent and Sussex Rother Levels Drainage Commissioners, and the Tillingham Valley Drainage Board; the abrogation of the powers of the Commissioners of Sewers for the Rapes of Pevensey and Hastings within the above-named Catchment Area; the constitution of new Internal Drainage Districts to be known as the Rother, the Walland Marsh and the Pett Drainage Districts and of Drainage

Boards for such Districts; and for certain matters supplemental thereto.
