The following Statute made by the University of Oxford, on the 18th day of October, 1932, has been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."

UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD.

STATUTE APPROVED BY CONGREGATION ON TUESDAY, 18TH OCTOBER, 1932.

WHEREAS it is expedient that women should be eligible for membership of Committees for the Nomination of Examiners and of the body of Curators of the Taylor Institution: NOW THE UNIVERSITY, in exercise of the powers in that behalf conferred upon it by the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, and of all other powers enabling it, ENACTS, subject to the approval of His Majesty in Council, AS FOLLOWS.
