

And whereas the Council of the said County has pursuant to section 12 of the said Act and to the Coroners (Orders as to Districts) Rules, 1927, submitted to the Secretary of State a draft order providing for the alteration of the existing division of the said County into Coroners' Districts by the formation of a new Coroners' District comprising the area in which the Franchise Coroner had jurisdiction:

Now therefore I the undersigned, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in pursuance of the power vested in me by section 12 of the said Act do hereby order that the County of Glamorgan shall include the following Coroner's District, namely, the Ogmore District comprising the parishes named in the Schedule hereto.

IMPORT DUTIES ACT, 1932.

Whereas it is provided by sub-section (1) of Section 9 of the Import Duties Act, 1932 (22 Geo. 5. ch. 8.) that, with a view to obtaining information as to the condition and progress of trades and industries engaged in the manufacture in the United Kingdom of goods of a class or description which, if they were imported into the United Kingdom, would be chargeable with a duty of customs under Part I of that Act, the Board of Trade may, before the commencement of the year nineteen hundred and thirty-three and any subsequent year, publish in the Gazette notice that they will require returns in relation to that year in accordance with the provision of the said section:

Now, therefore, the Board of Trade in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the said section, hereby give notice that returns will be required in relation to the year 1933 in respect of the trades and industries set out in the schedule hereto.
