

and issue by the Company of consolidated or other stock of the Company to the holders of shares in the Buckby Company and to make provision for cash payments in cases where holders of shares in the Buckby Company would be entitled to an amount of stock of the Company of less than one pound.

4. To cancel or provide for the cancellation of all the existing shares of the Buckby Company and to provide for and require the delivery up to the Company of certificates for shares of the Buckby Company and to authorise and require trustees executors and other persons to accept and hold such consolidated or other stock of the Company or cash in substitution for shares of the Buckby Company and to provide that references in deeds wills and other instruments to shares of the Buckby Company shall be construed as references to such stock of the Company.

5. To make provision as to the debts and liabilities of and moneys due or accrued to the Buckby Company and the recovery thereof, to provide for the dissolution and winding-up of the Buckby Company and to make all such other provisions as may be necessary or expedient for the purpose of enabling the said transfer and vesting to be carried into effect.

6. To extend the limits within which the Company are authorised to supply gas and to authorise the Company to supply gas within the parish of Pattishall in the Rural District of Towcester, the Parishes of Brockhall, Dodford, Long Buckby, West Haddon, and Whilton in the Rural District of Daventry, the Parishes of Coton, East Haddon, Guilsborough, Holdenby, Hollowell, Ravensthorpe and Teeton in the Rural District of Brixworth, all in the County of Northampton, and to authorise the Company within such extended limits to exercise all or any of the rights powers and privileges which they now may exercise within their existing limits of supply, and to make applicable to such extended limits any of the provisions of the Acts or Orders relating to the Company and of the Order.

7. To make provision as to the price to be charged for gas within the extended limits of supply and as to the method of charge and to provide that all or some of the provisions of the Gas Regulation Act 1920 and of the Northampton Gas (Charges) Order 1923 shall not apply in relation to the supply of gas by the Company in the extended limits.

8. To enable the Company to continue maintain and use any mains pipes and other works belonging to them at the commencement of the Order within the said parishes as if the same had been laid down or constructed under the powers of the Order.

9. To authorise the Company to maintain erect alter improve and renew gasworks and plant for the manufacture and storage of gas and to manufacture and store gas and work up and convert residual products upon the lands upon which the gasworks of the Buckby Company are situate hereinafter described and to deal in such products. The said lands are situate in the parish of Long Buckby in the County of Northampton and are as follows:—

(A) All that piece of land containing one rood or thereabouts bounded on or towards the West by the Public Carriage Road leading from Long Buckby to Murcott towards the North by a waggon road leading from the

before mentioned Carriage Road to Farm and lands now belonging to Mr. Haynes on or towards the East by a close of land belonging to the said Mr. Haynes and on or towards the South by the remaining part of an Orchard now used and occupied as gardens to certain cottages now or late belonging to Mr. Coles.

(B) Firstly all that piece of ground containing 5 poles or thereabouts situate at Mill Hill many years since in the occupation of John Sabin and secondly All that other piece of land containing 5 poles or thereabouts situate in Mill Hill aforesaid near to but separate from the piece of land before mentioned.

(C) All that piece or parcel of land situate on the North East side of the road leading to Murcott and known as Mill Hill containing by admeasurement 5 poles or thereabouts bounded on the North East by land then in the occupation of William Haynes on the South West by the said road on the South East and North West by other land now belonging to the Buckby Company.

(D) All that piece or parcel of land situate on the North East side of the road leading to Murcott and known as Mill Hill containing by admeasurement 5 poles or thereabouts bounded on the North East by land in the occupation of William Haynes on the South West by the said road on the South East by another plot of land of similar dimensions belonging to William Haynes Junior and on the North West by other land now belonging to the Buckby Company.

(E) All that piece or parcel of land situate on the North side of the road leading to Murcott and measuring in extent 5 poles or thereabouts bounded on the North by land in the occupation of William Haynes on the South by the said road and on the East and West by other pieces of land of similar dimensions belonging to the Buckby Company.

(F) All that piece or parcel of garden land situate on the North West of the high road adjoining or near to the Gas Works having a frontage to the said road of 19 feet or thereabouts and a depth of 103 feet or thereabouts.

(G) All that plot of garden ground situate on the North side of and abutting upon Mill Hill bounded on or towards the West by a similar plot of ground formerly belonging to James Blinco and on the East by a similar piece of ground formerly belonging to Thomas Lucas (both of which plots now belong to the Buckby Company) and on the North by a quick set hedge.

(H) All that garden ground situate lying and being to the East of the Mill Hill containing in the whole 5 poles or thereabouts which said piece of land was formerly in the occupation of John Sabin and Ellen Sabin his wife and bounded on the North and South by property belonging to the Buckby Company on the East by land belonging to William Haynes and on the West by Mill Hill aforesaid.

10. To confer further powers on the Company in relation to the inspection testing removal and replacement of meters, the cost of inspection and testing of meters, and the entry into unoccupied premises; to provide that the Com-
