Stockholme, April 20. N. S.

Esterday the Duke of Holstein arrived here, having been conducted through the Kingdom with great Marks of Respect. The King of Sueden rid about 10 English Miles to meet him, and at some distance from the City he was received by the Senators in a stage. There the King lest his Horso, and, together with the Duke, (to whom he gave the Hand) and the Prince his Brother, went into one of his Coaches, attended by the Coaches of the Senators, and other Persons of Quality, with 6 Horso each. Thus they proceeded to the Palace, where the Guns were fired, and discharges made by the Root Guards and City Militia, that were drawn up on this Occasion. The Duke and the Prince his Brother Dined with the King, and in the atternoon his Highness visited the Queen Mother, the two Princesses, and the Dutchess Dowager his Mother. The Compliments upon the approaching Marriage have been given, and received on all fides with great Expressions of Satisfaction, and it is thought that Solemnity will not be long deterred. The Count Actories, Ambassador from France, has lately had an Audience of the King of Sueden, in which he delivered to him a Letter from the Most Christian King; and he has since been several times in Conference with the Ministers at this Court, upon some Proposals from that Crown. The Alliance between this Kingdom and the House of Luzentong having been renewed by a Treaty made some time ago to that effect at Hambourg, the Ratifications of the same have lately been sent thince, in order to their being exchanged.

we faw, April 26. The Affairs of the General Dyet remain hisherto much in the fame condition; at their first Meeting they chose their Mareschal or Speaker, and that's all they have yet done, the Protest made by the Deputies of Lithuanis not suffering them to take any Resolution; All the Endeavours that have been used to persuade the said Deputies of Lithuanis to return to their places in the Dyer, have hitherto been inessessaid, they still persisting in their reusal to be present at any other Dyet but such as shall be held in the manner they desire: However they have confined to stay here till the return of the Expresses that have been dispatched to the Palatinates which they represent, to endeaveur to produce them new Instructions. Divers of the Gentry have made fresh Applications to the King of Paland, that he would send home all his German Forces; la answer to which he has declared, That it is not convenient to hasten their departure during the present posture of Affairs, but as soon as the Kingdom shall be restored to its former quiet, he will immediately send away his Troops. The Under-General of Lishuanis arrived here yesterday, and his had Audience of the King; He is a Favourer of the Sicur Oginisky, and those that Joan with him, and endeavours to justific their Proceedings: At the same time we hear General Sapitha's Party is considerably increased, and that he appears fully restived to pursue his Revenge of the Injuries done him by the contrary Faction. Vienna, April 30. The Popes Nuncio has lately received a coniderable Sum of Moncy from Rome, with Orders to dispose of the Iame for the Service of the Emperor's Forces, as he shall be directed by this Court. Last Saturday the Emperor made Everal Knights of the Golden-Fleece, among whom were the Princas of Eggenberg and Lichtenstein, Gount Warmen, Count Prince, and Count Than. Recruits are daily passing by this place in their way to Hungary, and the preparations for the Fleet on the Dambe are made with all possible expedition; a of the new built Galleys are already lamched, as the remaining two will likewise be very suddenly, so that they will in a short time tall down the River to Peter-Waradin, which is appointed for the Rendezvous of the Vessels that are this Sumner to be employed against the Turks. The Saxon Forces that served in Hungary being recalled by the King of Poland, are marching to that Kingdem, and will be followed by the Danes that are in the same Service, as soon as General Tramp, who is lately arrived here from Denmark, has adjusted with this Court some Matters relating to the Arrears due to the said forces. We have advice from Turkey, that the Horse Tails were hung out at Adrianople on the 26th of March, being the usual Signal of the Grand Signior's intention to go to the War.
