

WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT, 1925.

Upton, Old Mill, Eccleleshill, Bradford, subject to the conditions that a worker shall not be employed in the afternoon shift in consecutive weeks and that suitable accommodation for clothing put off during working hours and adequate means of warming food and boiling water shall be provided.
