APPOINTMENT OF STANDINGS FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES WITHIN THE METROPOLITAN POLICE DISTRICT, AND REGULATIONS TO BE OBSERVED.

By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."

I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby APPOINT Standings for Hackney Carriages at the following places, and do make the following Regulations with regard to the Boundaries for the same, viz. :—

APPOINTMENTS.

AT SHAFTESBURY AVENUE, W.
In eight portions.

Twenty-three Hackney Carriages:

First Portion.—One cab in centre of roadway, to stand immediately North of refuge opposite the Trocadero Restaurant.

Second Portion.—Two cabs in centre of roadway, commencing opposite entrance to No. 28 Shaftesbury Avenue, and extending Northward as far as necessary for two cabs.

Third Portion.—One cab in centre of roadway, to stand immediately South of refuge at Rupert Street.
