Twenty-three Hackney Carriages:

First Portion.—One Carriage in centre of roadway, to stand immediately North of refuge opposite the Trocadero Restaurant.

Second Portion.—Two carriages in centre of roadway, commencing opposite entrance to No. 28 Shaftesbury Avenue, and extending Northward as far as necessary for two carriages.

Third Portion.—One carriage in centre of roadway, to stand immediately South of refuge at Rupert Street.

Fourth Portion.—Three carriages in centre of roadway, commencing at a point opposite the Southern building line of the Globe Theatre and extending Northward as far as necessary for three carriages.

Fifth Portion.—Two carriages in centre of roadway, commencing at a point twelve yards South of refuge South of Wardour Street and extending Northward as far as necessary for two carriages.

Sixth Portion.—Three carriages in centre of roadway, commencing opposite the entrance to No. 53 Shaftesbury Avenue and extending Northward as far as necessary for three carriages.

Seventh Portion.—Three carriages in centre of roadway, commencing opposite the entrance to No. 67 Shaftesbury Avenue and extending Northward to South end of refuge.
