## ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport after the expiry of at least forty days from this date in pursuance of the power conferred upon him by the Road Traffic Act, 1930, to make Regulations amending the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations, 1931.

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency the Minister of Transport has under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) (Amendment) Provisional Regulations, 1933, to come into force forthwith as Provisional Regulations and to continue in force until Statutory Rules have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency the Minister of Transport has under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made the London Traffic (Restricted Streets) Amendment (Routes Nos. 12, 112 and 121) Provisional Regulations, 1933, to come into operation forthwith as Provisional Regulations to continue in force until Regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.

These Regulations provide for the re-arrangement of the omnibus services on routes Nos. 12 (Shepherds Bush and South Croydon), 112 (Harlesden and East Dulwich), and 121 (Mill Hill, The Broadway and East Dulwich).
