JUTE TRADE BOARD (GREAT BRITAIN).

In accordance with Regulations made by the Minister of Labour under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, and dated 21st April, 1927, the Jute Trade Board (Great Britain) HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they PROPOSE TO VARY the General Minimum Time-Rates, Guaranteed Time-Rates, General Minimum Piece-Rates, Piece-Work Basis Time-Rates and Overtime Rates for certain classes of Male and Female Workers at present set out in the Schedule to their Notice J.(53), dated 19th May, 1931.
