APPOINTMENT OF A STANDING FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES WITHIN THE METROPOLITAN POLICE DISTRICT, AND REGULATIONS TO BE OBSERVED.

By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."

I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby APPOINT a Standing for Hackney Carriages at the following place, and do make the following Regulations with regard to the Boundaries for the same, viz. :---

APPOINTMENT.

AT LEICESTER SQUARE, W. (NORTH AND WEST SIDES) In two portions.	Ten Hackney Carriages: First Portion.—On North side of Leicester Square, in centre of roadway, one cab to stand immediately East of the refuge opposite the women's lavatory. Front of cab toward the East. Second Portion.—At Leicester Square (West side) nine cabs on East side of roadway, commencing in line with a point immediately South of the refuge at North-west corner, extending Southward, by kerb, as far as necessary for nine cabs. Front of cabs toward the North. The first portion of the Standing to be available only between the hours of 2 p.m. and 10 p.m., and during those hours to be fed exclusively by cabs from the second portion.

Provided that no Hackney Carriage shall be suffered to stand across any street or thoroughfare, or opposite the end of any street or carriage-way, or upon any place where foot passengers usually cross the carriage-way.
