

Duchy of Lancaster Liberty in the County of Hertford:

And whereas on the 9th day of August, 1932, a vacancy occurred in the Office of Franchise Coroner for the said Liberty:

And whereas by the operation of Section 4 of the said Act the area over which the Franchise Coroner for the said Liberty had jurisdiction thereupon became merged in the County of Hertford for all purposes relating to Coroners:

And whereas the County of Hertford is at present divided into seven Coroners' Districts, and it is necessary to alter the existing division of the County so as to include the said Liberty in one of such Districts:

And whereas the Hertfordshire County Council have, pursuant to Section 12 of the said Act and to the Coroners (Orders as to Districts) Rules, 1927, submitted to the Secretary of State a draft Order providing for the alteration of the existing division of the County of Hertford into Coroners' Districts so as to include in the St. Albans Coroner's District the area of the said Liberty:

Now, therefore, I, the undersigned, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in pursuance of the power vested in me by Section 12 of the Coroners (Amendment) Act, 1926, do hereby order that the existing division of the County of Hertford into Coroners' Districts shall be altered so that the St. Albans Coroner's District shall comprise the parishes set out in the Schedule hereto.

This Order shall come into operation on the twentieth day of March, 1933.
