REPORT OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE.

PENCILS AND PENCIL STRIPS.

With reference to the notice which was published in the London, Edinburgh and Belfast Gazettes of the 22nd July, 1932, regarding a reference made by the Board of Trade to the Standing Committee under the Merchandise Marks Act, 1926, in respect of imported goods of the following descriptions:—

(a) pencils consisting of strips made wholly or partly of graphite, carbon, chalk, gypsum, talc, colours or dyestuffs, encased in wood, paper, or other materials, but not including propelling pencils;

(b) strips of the descriptions set out above including those for propelling and other mechanical pencils,

the Board of Trade hereby give notice, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2, Sub-section 7, that a Report has been made by the Committee in respect of the aforesaid descriptions of goods.
