BOROUGH OF ACTON.

PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1907, AND  
PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, 1925.

**B**Y an Order dated the fourth day of March, 1933, the Minister of Health has declared that, on and after the twentieth day of March, 1933, Part VI of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, and Part VI of the Public Health Act, 1925, shall be in force in the Borough of Acton.

The Minister of Health has repealed, as from the said date, the undermentioned provisions of the Acton Improvement Act, 1904, namely:—

The words "for cricket bowls football tennis and other games and" and the words "games or" in section 106 (power to set apart and close pleasure grounds).

Section 107 (Council may erect band stands etc.).

Section 108 (bands of music).

Section 109 (power to provide apparatus for games).

The words "public park garden or pleasure ground" in section 110 (chairs and seats for public use).
