CANCELLATION OF A STANDING FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES.

By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."

I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby CANCEL the appointment of the following Standing for Hackney Carriages at the following place:—

CANCELLATION.

AT STATION ROAD, BALHAM ...

Twenty Hackney Carriages in two portions:

First Portion.—Twelve carriages on the South side of roadway, commencing at a point by the North Entrance to the Railway Station, and extending Eastward, by kerb, as far as necessary for twelve carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the West.

Second Portion.—Eight carriages on the South side of roadway, commencing at a point opposite No. 12, Station Road, and extending Eastward, by kerb, as far as necessary for eight carriages.

Front of vehicles toward the West.

The first portion of the Standing to be fed exclusively by carriages from the second portion, *which is to be approached by way of Bedford Hill.*
