#### Office of the High Commissioner for India, 1933.

The Secretary of State for India in Council  
has appointed Mr. Thomas Wilfred Taylor,  
Deputy Superintendent, Mercantile Marine  
Office, Newcastle, to superintend the transfer  
of lascars and other persons, and to grant the  
certificate required under section 125 of the  
Merchant Shipping Act, 1894 (57 and 58 Vic.  
cap. 60).

The fee to be paid for every lascar, or other  
person in respect of whom such certificate is  
applied for, is limited to three shillings and  
in no case is the total amount of fees in respect  
of one crew to exceed five pounds.

#### RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

#### IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Pub-  
lication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the  
Minister of Transport after the expiration of  
at least 40 days from this date in pursuance  
of the powers conferred upon him by Section  
10 of the aforesaid London Traffic Act, to make  
Regulations in regard to schemes of "one-  
way" traffic working:—

(a) in Charles Street, Westminster, between  
Chesterfield Street and Waverton Street;

(b) at the junction of Kew Bridge Road,  
Chiswick High Road, Spring Grove and Kew  
Bridge Approach, Chiswick.
