

The Home Secretary gives notice that in pursuance of Section 2 (1) of the Employment of Women, Young Persons and Children Act, 1920, he has made an Order authorising the employment on two day-shifts of women of 18 years of age and over in the manufacture of twine and cord at the Hay Cord Arches works of the London Spinning Company Limited, Trundley's Road, Deptford, in two shifts, subject to the conditions that a worker shall not be employed in the afternoon shift in consecutive weeks, and that suitable accommodation for clothing put off during working hours, messroom accommodation and washing facilities shall be provided.
