after the 26th June the importation of German cherries is prohibited except of those accompanied by certificates issued by the German Phytopathological Service to the effect that the cherries were not grown south of latitude 53° N. or in East Prussia.

Cherries grown in other European countries and imported after the 27th May must be accompanied by certificates of origin.

The certificates prescribed in the Order must be delivered to the Officer of Customs and Excise with the entry relating to the consignment.

Cherries landed without the certificates prescribed in the Order must be destroyed at the expense of the importer unless they are reexported or are disposed of in accordance with the terms of a licence issued by an Inspector of the Ministry. An Inspector may enter any premises and open, examine and take samples of any cherries shipped or believed to have been shipped from any country other than Scotland, Ireland, the Channel Islands or the Isle of Man; any person wilfully obstructing or impeding an Inspector in the exercise of these powers, or failing to comply with the provisions relating to destruction or re-exportation, or with the terms of a licence, is liable to a penalty of £10, or in respect of a second or subsequent offence, to a penalty of £50.

The Order remains in force until the 30th September, 1933.
