

APPOINTMENT OF A STANDING FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES WITHIN THE METROPOLITAN POLICE DISTRICT, AND REGULATIONS TO BE OBSERVED.

By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."

I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby APPOINT a Standing for Hackney Carriages at the following place, and do make the following Regulations with regard to the Boundaries for the same, viz.:—

AT OXFORD STREET, W. ...	<p>Four Hackney Carriages: In centre of roadway, commencing at a point in line with the entrance to No. 538, extending Eastward as far as necessary for four cabs. Front of cabs toward the West. <i>Note.</i>—This Standing will only be available between the hours of 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.</p>

Provided that no Hackney Carriage shall be suffered to stand across any street or thoroughfare, or opposite the end of any street or carriage-way, or upon any place where foot passengers usually cross the carriage-way.
