AT PICCADILLY, W. (STRATTON STREET).	Twelve Hackney Carriages: On South side of roadway, commencing by the electric light standard opposite Stratton Street, extending Westward, by kerb, as far as necessary for twelve cabs. Front of cabs toward the East.

APPOINTMENT OF STANDINGS FOR HACKNEY CARRIAGES WITHIN THE METROPOLITAN POLICE DISTRICT, AND REGULATIONS TO BE OBSERVED.

By virtue of the Act 13 and 14 Victoria, chapter 7, intituled "An Act for Consolidating the Office of the Registrar of Metropolitan Public Carriages with the Office of Commissioners of Police of the Metropolis, and making other provisions in regard to the Consolidated Offices."

I, the undersigned, Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, do hereby APPOINT Standings for Hackney Carriages at the following places, and do make the following Regulations with regard to the Boundaries for the same, viz. :—

APPOINTMENTS.

AT UPPER CHARLES STREET, FINSBURY.	Three Hackney Carriages: In centre of roadway, commencing at a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 21/22, extending Westward as far as necessary for three cabs. Front of cabs toward the East.

27th June, 1933.

AT PICCADILLY, W. (STRATTON STREET).	Twelve Hackney Carriages: On South side of roadway, commencing at a point thirty-five feet East of the Eastern building line of Stratton Street, extending Westward, by kerb, as far as necessary for twelve cabs. Front of cabs toward the East.

Provided that no Hackney Carriage shall be suffered to stand across any street or thoroughfare, or opposite the end of any street or carriage-way, or upon any place where foot passengers usually cross the carriage-way.
