## BOROUGH OF YEOVIL.

## PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, 1925.

BY an Order made under Section 77 of the Public Health Act, 1925, the Minister of Health has prescribed the rate of interest recoverable by the Council of the borough of Yeovil in respect of expenses for private street works at 4 per cent. per annum or such less rate as the Council may from time to time determine instead of 5 per cent. per annum. The order is applicable to expenses incurred by the Council after the 7th day of September, 1925, and in respect of which a demand for payment shall have been served on or after the 10th day of July, 1933.

The order will cease to have effect, subject as therein mentioned, on the 10th day of July, 1935.
