PROPOSED ALTERATION OF COUNTY BOUNDARIES.

NOTICE is hereby given that the County Councils for the Administrative Counties of the County of Cumberland and the County Palatine of Lancaster have by Memorial dated the 8th day of August, 1933, made a Representation to the Minister of Health, in accordance with Section 54 of the Local Government Act, 1888, that it is desirable that the boundaries of the Administrative Counties of Cumberland and Lancaster shall be altered by transferring the portion of the Parish of Millom Rural situate within the Administrative County of Cumberland and lying on the easterly side of the River Duddon and numbered 1 on the map accompanying the Repre-

sentation from the County of Cumberland to the County of Lancaster and by transferring portions of the Townships of Dunnerdale-with-Seathwaite and Broughton West situate within the Administrative County of Lancaster and lying on the westerly side of the said River Duddon, and numbered 2, 3, and 4 respectively on the said map, from the County of Lancaster to the County of Cumberland, and also, as consequential on the alterations of the County boundaries, that it is desirable to make the necessary alterations in the areas of the Rural Districts and Townships as more particularly described in the said Representation, and that a copy of the said Representation and a duplicate of the said map accompanying the Representation have been deposited at the Office of the Clerk of the Cumberland County Council at The Courts, Carlisle, and at the Office of the Clerk of the Lancashire County Council, County Offices, Preston, and will be there open for inspection during the usual office hours, without payment, by any Local Authority having jurisdiction within the areas, or by any person affected by the proposal.
