

the said Benefice of Facombe shall be the first Incumbent of the United Benefice of Facombe with Combe.

"4. That upon the said unions taking effect (a) pending the provision of a new Parsonage House situate at Ham for the United Benefice of Ham with Buttermere, the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said Benefice of Ham shall become and be the house of residence for the Incumbent of the United Benefice of Ham with Buttermere, (b) the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said Benefice of Facombe shall become and be the house of residence for the Incumbent of the United Benefice of Facombe with Combe and (c) so soon as conveniently may be after the unions have taken effect the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said Benefice of Buttermere with Combe and the site and appurtenances thereof and the grounds heretofore usually occupied and enjoyed therewith shall be sold and disposed of by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners at such time or times and in such manner in all respects as to us shall seem expedient and that the net proceeds of such sale shall be held and accumulated by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for and towards the cost of the provision of a new Parsonage House for the United Benefice of Ham with Buttermere.

"5. That after the said unions have taken effect the course and succession in which the respective Patrons shall present or nominate to the United Benefices from time to time as the same shall become vacant shall be as follows, that is to say (a) the right of presentation to the United Benefice of Ham with Buttermere shall be exercised by the Patrons of the said two Benefices of Ham and Buttermere with Combe alternately, the Patrons of the said Benefice of Buttermere with Combe having the right upon the first presentation to the United Benefice of Ham with Buttermere to be made after the union and every alternate right of presentation and the Patron of the said Benefice of Ham having the right of presentation upon the second presentation to the same United Benefice to be made after the union and every alternate turn thereafter, and (b) in every series of three successive turns of presentation or nomination to be made to the United Benefice of Facombe with Combe after the union the Patrons of the said Benefice of Buttermere with Combe shall have the first turn and the Patron of the said Benefice of Facombe shall have the second and the third turns.

"6. That upon the unions taking effect all the glebe situate within the Parish of the said Benefice of Buttermere and all Tithe Rent Charges arising within the said Parish of Buttermere, and now or formerly belonging to the said United Benefice of Buttermere with Combe, together with all capital sums of money and stocks (if any) representing or being the produce of the sale, redemption or other conversion of any part or parts of such Tithe Rentcharge shall subject as hereinafter provided become and be part of the endowments of the United Benefice of Ham with Buttermere, and all other the endowments of the said United Benefice of Buttermere with Combe shall subject as

aforsaid become and be part of the endowments of the United Benefice of Facombe with Combe.

"7. That with the consent of the said Charles Rhodes Hall (testified by his signing this Scheme), if upon the date of the unions taking effect the pension now payable to the said Charles Rhodes Hall as aforesaid shall still be payable, such pension shall be apportioned as follows, that is to say, a portion equal to seven-twelfths of such pension shall be charged upon the revenues of the United Benefice of Ham with Buttermere and the remaining portion of such pension shall be charged upon the revenues of the United Benefice of Facombe with Combe.

"8. That upon the unions taking effect or upon the cessation of the pension now payable as aforesaid to the said Charles Rhodes Hall, whichever shall be later, a part of the endowments of the United Benefice of Ham with Buttermere shall be appropriated as follows, that is to say, the Tithe Redemption Annuity amounting to £17 10s. at present payable to the Governors of Queen Anne's Bounty for the benefit of the said United Benefice of Buttermere with Combe and the Tithe Redemption Annuity amounting to £184 17s. 7d. at present payable to the said Governors for the benefit of the said Benefice of Ham, and the sinking funds held by the said Governors in respect of the same annuities, shall be applied as follows, that is to say, the said two tithe redemption annuities shall be payable to and the said sinking funds shall be held by the said Governors as to three fifth parts thereof for the benefit of the United Benefice of Ham with Buttermere and as to the remaining two fifth parts for the benefit of the Benefice of Westbury, in the said Diocese of Salisbury.

"9. That upon the unions taking effect or upon the cessation of the pension now payable as aforesaid to the said Charles Rhodes Hall whichever shall be later, a part of the endowments of the United Benefice of Facombe with Combe, namely a sum of £1,777 15s. 7d. Local Loans £3 per cent. per annum Stock at present held by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for the benefit of the said Benefice of Facombe, together with an annual payment of £26 13s. 4d. being part of a larger annual payment now made by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners to the Incumbent for the time being of the said United Benefice of Buttermere with Combe shall be excepted out of the union and shall be applied for the benefit of the Benefice of Hurstbourne Tarrant, in the said Diocese of Winchester.

"Provided always that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Measure, or of any other Measure of the National Assembly of the Church of England, or of any Act of Parliament."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme have been duly published in accordance with the provisions of the said Union of Benefices Measure, 1923, and Notices have been transmitted to the persons or bodies entitled under the same Measure to receive Notice requiring any objections to such draft Scheme to be stated or transmitted in writing to the said
