

extending thence south westward along the middle of Wisewood Avenue for a distance of 3 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Owlings Road, and extending thence first north westward and then westward along the middle of Owlings Road for a distance of 12 chains or thereabouts to a point in the wall or fence at its western end, and extending thence in a straight line due north (thereby crossing the Wadsley Reservoir) for a distance of  $8\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to a point in the middle of Ben Lane, and extending thence westward along the middle of Ben Lane for a distance of 15 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Studfield Hill, and extending thence south westward along the middle of Studfield Hill for a distance of 37 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Loxley Road, and extending thence eastward along the middle of Loxley Road for a distance of 15 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Low Matlock Lane, and extending thence south westward along the middle of Low Matlock Lane for a distance of  $5\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to its junction with the roadway leading to the Glass Tilt Wire Works, and extending thence southward in a straight line for a distance of 3 chains or thereabouts to a point in the middle of the northern end of the weir at the eastern side of the said Wire Works, and continuing thence southward in the same direction and in a straight line for a distance of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to a point in the middle of the River Loxley, and extending thence eastward along the middle of the River Loxley (thereby following the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Wadsley from the said New Parish of Stannington) for a distance of  $5\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to the northern end of the fence which divides the close numbered 808 upon the Ordnance Survey Map of the Civil Parish of Bradfield published in the year 1923 on the scale of 25 inches to a mile and also upon the map or plan annexed to this Scheme from the close numbered 806 upon the same maps, and extending thence south eastward first to the said fence and then along the fences which divide the said close numbered 808 and the closes numbered 807 and 803 upon the said maps from the said close numbered 806 and the close numbered 804 upon the same maps for a distance of  $14\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to the point where the fence which divides the said close numbered 803 from the said close numbered 804 reaches the northern side of Myers Grove Lane, and extending thence first southward to and then westward along the middle of Myers Grove Lane for a distance in all of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to the northern end of the fence which divides the close numbered 246 upon the Ordnance Survey Map of the County Borough of Sheffield published in the year 1923 on the scale of 25 inches to a mile and also upon the said map or plan annexed to this Scheme from the close numbered 240 upon the last mentioned maps, and extending thence south eastward first to such fence and then along the fences which divide the said close numbered 246 and the closes numbered 245, 244 and 243 upon the last mentioned maps from the said close numbered 240 and the closes numbered 241 and 242 upon the same maps for a distance of  $21\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to the point where the fence which divides the said close numbered 243

from the said close numbered 242 reaches the northern side of Wood Lane, and extending thence first south eastward to and then north eastward along the middle of Wood Lane for a distance of  $8\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to the northern end of the fence forming the western boundary of the houses and premises situate on the western side of Barlow Road, and extending thence south eastward to and along such fence and along the fence in continuation thereof for a distance in all of  $12\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to the point where the last mentioned fence reaches the north western side of Stannington Road, and extending thence first south eastward to and then south westward along the middle of Stannington Road for a distance in all of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to its junction with Rivelin Park Road, and extending thence southward along the middle of Rivelin Park Road for a distance of  $11\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to its junction with the road called Hollins, and extending thence eastward along the middle of Hollins (thereby crossing the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Stannington from the said New Parish of Saint Mary, Walkley, and following for a short distance the boundary which divides the New Parish of Saint Timothy, Crookes, in the said County and Diocese, from the said New Parish of Saint Mary, Walkley), for a distance of  $5\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to its junction with Rivelin Road and Rivelin Valley Road, and extending thence north eastward along the middle of Rivelin Valley Road for a distance of 42 chains or thereabouts to the centre of the bridge which carries it across the River Loxley and extending thence first eastward and then north eastward along the middle of the River Loxley (thereby following for a short distance the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Mary, Walkley, from the said New Parish of Saint John the Baptist, Owlerton) for a distance of  $39\frac{1}{2}$  chains or thereabouts to the centre of the bridge which carries Langsett Road across the River Loxley, at which point the said imaginary line commenced."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme have, in accordance with the provisions of the secondly herein-before mentioned Act, been transmitted to the Patrons and to the Incumbents of the Cures out of which it is intended that the District recommended in such Scheme to be constituted shall be taken, and such Patrons and Incumbents have respectively signified their assent to such Scheme:

And whereas the said Scheme has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Scheme, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts.

And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said Diocese of Sheffield.
