##### BRIGHTLINGSEA (SHELL-FISH) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (No. 2), 1933.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Health, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, to make Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Public Health Act, 1875, as amended by the Public Health Act, 1896, and the Public Health (Regulations as to Food) Act, 1907, for the purposes of postponing until 10th day of January, 1934, the date of operation of the Brightlingsea (Shell-Fish) Regulations, 1932, as amended by the Brightlingsea (Shell-Fish) (Amendment) Regulations, 1933:

And that on account of urgency the Minister of Health under section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, has for the purpose aforesaid made Regulations entitled the Brightlingsea (Shell-Fish) (Amendment) Regulations (No. 2), 1933, to come into force immediately as provisional regulations, to continue in force until regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of section 1 of that Act.
