I do hereby give notice that it hath been certified to me in writing under the hands of Two Members, serving in this present Parliament in the manner required by the said Act, that Sir Frank Boyd Merriman, O.B.E., K.C., late a Member serving in this present Parliament for the Borough of Manchester, Rusholme Division, hath accepted the Office of President of the Probate, Divorce and Admiralty Division of the High Court of Justice and has been Gazetted thereto in the London Gazette dated the third day of October, 1933, and has thereby vacated his Seat, and that I shall issue my Warrant to the Clerk of the Crown to make out a new Writ for the Electing of a Member to serve in this present Parliament for the said Borough at the end of six days after the insertion of this notice in the London Gazette.
