

stituted a separate District in the manner which is hereinafter set forth:

"And whereas there is not at present within the limits of the said proposed separate District any consecrated Church or Chapel in use for the purposes of Divine Worship:

"And whereas we have agreed to make and pay out of the Common Fund created by the firstly herein mentioned Act a grant of £200 per annum to the Minister of the said proposed separate District so soon as a Minister shall have been duly licensed in accordance with the provisions of the secondly herein mentioned Act and to his successors:

"And whereas the said grant of the said yearly sum of £200 will, after the publication in the London Gazette of an Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme, be made and secured by an Instrument to be executed by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, under our Common Seal, in accordance with the provisions of the Act of the 29th and 30th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 111:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Henry, Bishop of Southwell (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly recommend and propose that all that part of the said New Parish of Saint Thomas, Kirkby in Ashfield, which is described in the Schedule hereunder written, all which part together with the boundaries thereof is delineated and set forth on the map or plan hereunto annexed, shall, upon and from the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme as aforesaid, become and be constituted a separate District for spiritual purposes and that the same shall be named 'The District of Saint Andrew, East Kirby'.

"And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts, or of any of them, or of any other Act of Parliament.

"THE SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme has reference.

"The District of Saint Andrew, East Kirkby, being:—

"All that part of the New Parish (sometimes District) of Saint Thomas, Kirkby in Ashfield, in the County of Nottingham and in the Diocese of Southwell, which is bounded upon the west by the Parish of Kirkby in Ashfield, upon the north and upon the north-east by the Parish of Sutton in Ashfield, both in the said County and Diocese, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the south-east and upon the south, by an imaginary line commencing at the point where the boundary which divides the said Parish of Sutton in Ashfield from the said New Parish of Saint Thomas, Kirkby in Ashfield, crosses the middle of the main road from Derby to Mansfield, and extending thence south-westward along the middle of the said road for a distance of 42 chains or thereabouts to a point opposite to the eastern end of the fence forming the boundary between the close numbered 124 upon the Ordnance Survey Map of the

Civil Parish of Kirkby in Ashfield published in the year 1916 on the scale of 25 inches to a mile and also upon the map or plan annexed to this Scheme from the close numbered 123 upon the same maps, and extending thence north-westward to and along such fence for a distance of 19½ chains or thereabouts to its western end on the eastern side of the roadway leading from Diamond Avenue to Titchfield Farm, and extending thence westward in a straight line across the said roadway for a distance of 6 yards or thereabouts to the eastern end of the fence forming the boundary between the close numbered 125 and the close numbered 110 upon the said maps, and extending thence first westward, then southward and then again westward along the fences which divide the said close numbered 125 and the closes numbered 144a and 146 upon the said maps from the said close numbered 110 and the closes numbered 109 and 147 upon the same maps for a distance of 23½ chains or thereabouts to the point where the fence which divides the said close numbered 146 from the said close numbered 147 reaches the eastern side of Hoggs Lane, and extending thence first north-westward to and then westward along the middle of Hoggs Lane for a distance of 7 chains or thereabouts to the point where it turns southward, and extending thence westward to and along the wall or fence forming the boundary between the houses and premises known as Number 52 and Number 54 Clumber Street for a distance of 2 chains or thereabouts to the point where such wall or fence reaches the eastern side of Clumber Street and extending thence westward across Clumber Street to and along the footpath which leads across Welbeck Street and Titchfield Park for a distance of 11½ chains or thereabouts to the point where it reaches the eastern side of School Street opposite to the eastern end of Sherwood Street and extending thence westward to and along the middle of Sherwood Street for a distance of 13 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Low Moor Road, and extending thence southward along the middle of Low Moor Road for a distance of 4½ chains or thereabouts to its junction with Pond Street, and extending thence westward along the middle of Pond Street for a distance of 10 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Factory Road, and continuing thence westward in precisely the same direction in a straight line (thereby crossing the Nottingham and Mansfield line and the Mansfield and Pinxton Line of the London Midland and Scottish Railway) for a distance of 16½ chains or thereabouts to a point in the middle of the Leen Valley Extension Line of the London and North Eastern Railway upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Thomas, Kirkby in Ashfield, from the said Parish of Kirkby in Ashfield."

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme have, in accordance with the provisions of the secondly herein-before mentioned Act, been transmitted to the Patron and to the Incumbent of the New Parish of Saint Thomas, Kirkby in Ashfield, out of which it is intended that the District recommended in such Scheme to be constituted shall be taken, and such Patron and Incumbent have respectively signified their assent to such Scheme:
