And whereas the said Scheme has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to ratify the said Scheme, and to order and direct that the same and every part thereof shall be effectual in law immediately from and after the time when this Order shall have been duly published in the London Gazette pursuant to the said Acts.

And His Majesty, by and with the like advice, is pleased hereby to direct that this Order be forthwith registered by the Registrar of the said Diocese of Southwell.

WHEREAS the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England have, in pursuance of the Act of the 7th and 8th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 94, of the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, and of the Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, duly prepared, and laid before His Majesty in Council, a Scheme or Representation, bearing date the 12th day of October, 1933, in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"We, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting under the provisions of the Act of the 7th and 8th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, Chapter 94, the Act of the 13th and 14th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, and the Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94, have prepared, and now humbly lay before Your Majesty in Council, the following Scheme or Representation for altering the boundaries of the New Parish of Darnall, in the County of York and in the Diocese of Sheffield:

"Whereas by the authority of an Order of Her said late Majesty in Council bearing date the 13th day of December, 1844, and published in the London Gazette on the 31st day of the same month, a separate District for spiritual purposes was constituted out of the Chapelry of Attercliffe cum Darnall, in the Parish of Sheffield, in the said County of York, and at that time in the Diocese of York, but now in the said Diocese of Sheffield, and the said District was named 'The District of Darnall':

"And whereas the said District of Darnall has become a New Parish of the character contemplated by the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37, by the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 104, and by the above mentioned Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94:

"And whereas it has been represented to us and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the said New Parish of Darnall should be altered in the manner which is hereinafter mentioned:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Leonard Hedley, Bishop of Sheffield (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme or Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent, recommend and propose that, from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme or Representation and without any assurance in the law other that such duly gazetted Order, the boundaries of the said New Parish of Darnall shall be altered so that all that portion of the Parish of Handsworth, in the said County of York and in the said Diocese of Sheffield which is described in the Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured pink, shall be dissevered from such Parish and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Darnall.

"And we further represent, recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing, recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts, or of any of them, or of any other Act of Parliament.

"THE SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

"The territory to be annexed to the New Parish of Darnall, in the County of York and in the Diocese of Sheffield, being:---

"All that portion of the Parish of Handsworth, in the said County and Diocese, which is bounded upon the north east by the New Parish of Saint George, Brinsworth, upon the north by the Chapelry of Tinsley, both in the said County and Diocese, upon the west by the said New Parish of Darnall, and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the south, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Darnall from the said Parish of Handsworth at a point in the middle of Carr Brook opposite to the south western end of the fence forming the north western boundary of Bowden Housteads Wood, and extending thence north eastward to and along such fence for a distance of 14 chains or thereabouts to its north eastern end, and extending thence first north westward to and then north eastward along the middle of the footpath leading towards Bowdenhouse Farm for a distance in all of 5¹/₂ chains or thereabouts to the point where such footpath reaches the roadway leading through Bowdenhouse Farm, and extend-ing thence first north westward to and then north eastward along the wall or fence forming the northern boundary of the last mentioned roadway and along the wall forming the northern boundary of Bowdenhouse Farmhouse for a distance in all of 8 chains or thereabouts to a point on the western side of the road leading from Handsworth to Darnall, and extending thence first north eastward to and then north westward along the middle of the last mentioned road for a distance in all of 13 chains or thereabouts to the centre of Handsworth Bridge which carries such road across the Manchester and Cleethorpes Line of the London and North Eastern Railway
