RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

PUBLIC HEALTH (IMPORTED FOOD) REGULATIONS, 1925.

PUBLIC HEALTH (IMPORTED FOOD) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS, 1933.

The Minister of Health gives notice in pursuance of the above named Regulations that he hereby recognises for the purposes of items (a) and (c) of the Second Schedule to the Amendment Regulations, i.e. :—

- (a) A severed part of the carcase of an animal (including the head or any part thereof, and the whole carcase without the head, but not including any part of the carcase of a pig which has been salted, cured, pickled, dried or smoked or otherwise prepared in the manner in which bacon or ham is ordinarily prepared), from which no submaxillary, pre-scapular, pre-crural, superficial inguinal, supramammary, or popliteal gland has been taken out;
