Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under Section 4 (3) of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, proposes to make an Order confirming a scheme submitted to him by the River Kent Catchment Board under Section 4 (1) (b) of the Act, making provision for the abolition of the Helsington, Levens, Underbarrow and Bradleyfield Drainage Authority, the Crosthwaite and Lyth Drainage Authority and the Meathop and Witherslack Drainage Board; the re-constitution of the Lyth Levens and Meathop Drainage Board; and for certain matters supplemental thereto.

PRESTON CORPORATION ELECTRICITY
(EXTENSION).

NOTICE is hereby given that the Mayor, Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Preston (hereinafter referred to

as "the Corporation") whose address is Municipal Building, Preston, have applied to the Electricity Commissioners under the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1933 for a Special Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

1. To extend the area for the supply of electrical energy by the Corporation so as to enable them to provide and distribute electrical energy for all public and private purposes as defined by the Electricity (Supply) Acts 1882 to 1933 within the Urban District of Preesall in the County Palatine of Lancaster (hereinafter referred to as "the added area").

2. To authorise the Corporation to exercise within the added area all powers usually conferred upon distributors of electrical energy.

3. To make provision as to the maximum prices which may be charged by the Corporation for electricity within the added area.

4. To authorise the Corporation to break up streets and parts of streets not repairable by the local authority and the railway within the added area.

5. To empower the Corporation to purchase and the Preesall Urban District Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") to sell the undertaking of the Council authorised by the Preesall Electricity Special Order 1925 and the rights powers authorities privileges obligations and liabilities of the Council as undertakers under and in respect of the said Order.

6. To apply to the added area with or without modification all or some of the provisions of the Preston Corporation Act and Orders 1922 to 1931 and the Preston Corporation Act 1933.

And notice is hereby also given that any authority, company, body or person desirous of bringing before the Electricity Commissioners any objections respecting the application must do so by registered letter addressed to the Secretary, Electricity Commission, Savoy Court, Strand, W.C.2, and despatched on or before the 12th day of February, 1934, and a copy of such objections must also be forwarded to the undermentioned Town Clerk or Parliamentary Agents.

Printed copies of the draft Order as applied for can be obtained at the price of two shillings for each copy at the offices of the undermentioned Town Clerk and Parliamentary Agents and from the offices of the Preesall Urban District Council, Preesall.

A copy of the draft Order and of the map relating to the application has been deposited for public inspection at the office of the Clerk of the Peace for the County Palatine of Lancaster at Preston and at the office of the Clerk to the Preesall Urban District Council at Preesall.
