FUSTIAN CUTTING TRADE BOARD (GREAT BRITAIN).

PROPOSAL TO FIX MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES FOR CERTAIN CLASSES OF MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS.

In accordance with Regulations made under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, by the Minister of Labour, and dated 21st April, 1927, the Fustian Cutting Trade Board (Great Britain) HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they PROPOSE TO FIX General Minimum Time-Rates, Piece-Work Basis Time-Rates, General Minimum Piece-Rates and Overtime Rates for certain classes of Male and Female Workers.

Particulars of the Proposed Minimum Rates may be obtained on application to the Secretary of the Trade Board at the address given below.

In accordance with Section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, the Trade Board will CONSIDER ANY OBJECTIONS to the above Proposal to Fix which may be lodged with them within two months from the 6th day of February, 1934. Such Objections should be in writing and signed by the person making the same (adding his or her full name and address) and should be sent to the Secretary, Fustian Cutting Trade Board (Great Britain), 1, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W.1. It is desirable that Objections should state precisely and, so far as possible, with reasons, what is objected to.
