

(b) In the contributory places of Broxbourne and Wormley:—

Sections 39 to 42 (inclusive) comprised in Part III (sanitary provisions).

(c) In the contributory place of Stanstead Abbots:—

Section 49 comprised in Part III (sanitary provisions).

The above provisions are declared to be in force subject, as regards Sections 23 and 30 of Part II and Sections 35 and 38 of Part III to the conditions specified in the Order.

The expenses incurred or payable by the council in the execution of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph (b) of Section 1 of this Order (except so far as those expenses may relate to their establishment and officers) shall be special expenses within the meaning of the Public Health Act, 1875, chargeable upon the contributory place in respect of which they may have been incurred.

NEWCASTLE - UNDER - LYME ELECTRICITY (EXTENSION) SPECIAL ORDER, 1934.

ELECTRICITY (SUPPLY) ACTS, 1882 TO 1933.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Electricity Commissioners have submitted to the Minister of Transport for confirmation under the above-mentioned Acts a Special Order made by them for the supply by the Borough of Newcastle-under-Lyme, of electricity within so much of the said borough as immediately prior to the coming into operation of the Borough of Newcastle-under-Lyme (Extension) Order, 1931, formed the urban district of Wolstanton United part of the urban district of Audley and the parish of Clayton and part of the parish of Keele in the rural district of Newcastle-under-Lyme in the County of Stafford.

The Minister of Transport proposes to confirm the Order and gives notice that any person affected who may be desirous of objecting to the confirmation of the same must in accordance with the Electricity (Confirmation of Special Orders) Rules, 1931, do so by memorial addressed to the Minister of Transport written on one side only of foolscap paper and sent by registered post addressed to The Secretary, Ministry of Transport, 6, Whitehall Gardens, London, S.W.1, and posted not later than the 5th May, 1934. A copy of any such memorial must also be sent in like manner to Messrs. Sharpe, Pritchard & Company, Palace Chambers, Bridge Street, Westminster, London, S.W.1, Parliamentary Agents for the Order. Such memorial must be sealed or signed by the person objecting or by some responsible and duly authorised person on his behalf, and must

state the specific grounds of objection to the order and the modifications desired.

A copy of the Order as submitted for confirmation has been deposited for public inspection at the offices of the Town Clerk, Newcastle-under-Lyme, and at the office of the Education Committee of the Corporation, Moreton House, Wolstanton, Newcastle-under-Lyme.

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1932.
BOURNEMOUTH TOWN PLANNING SCHEME No. 5.**

NOTICE is hereby given that (i) On the 28th day of March 1934 the Minister of Health notified his approval of the Resolution of the Council of the County Borough of Bournemouth dated the 2nd day of January 1934 deciding to prepare the above planning scheme with reference to an area situate wholly within the County Borough of Bournemouth; (ii) A certified copy of the map defining the area to which the resolution applies has been deposited at the Town Hall, Bournemouth, and will be open for inspection by all persons interested, without charge, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on all weekdays (except Saturdays) and on Saturdays between the hours of 10 a.m. and 12 noon; (iii) Any person who is or claims to be an owner of any property in the area, and any association representing owners of property within the Borough of Bournemouth, and any local association representing business or industry, may by notice in writing (specifying, in the case of an owner, the property of which he claims to be the owner), require the Bournemouth Borough Council to register, without charge, his or their name and address for the service of subsequent notices relating to the scheme.

Under the Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1933,* the development of land in the area during the preparation of the scheme is permitted to the extent specified in the Order, and in addition, the Bournemouth Borough Council are empowered to permit other development in the area during this period, with a view, in either case, to protecting the development from the risk of removal or alteration without compensation under the Scheme when approved and in operation. A print of the Order has been deposited together with the aforesaid map.
