

Common Seal, we humbly recommend and propose that upon the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme, and without any Conveyance, Assurance or Act in the Law other than such duly published Order, the lands, tenements and hereditaments particularly described in the Schedule hereunder written, with their appurtenances and all our right, title, estate and interest therein, subject to and with the benefit of the leases referred to and set out in the said Schedule, shall be assigned and transferred to the said Govern-

ing Body for the support of the said School and shall become and be absolutely vested in the said Governing Body and the said Governing Body shall become and be absolutely entitled to the rents, profits and proceeds of such lands tenements and hereditaments as from the 29th day of September, 1933.

"And we further recommend and propose that the annual money payment heretofore payable by us under the provisions of the above-mentioned Act shall as from the said 29th day of September, 1933, cease and determine.
