(2) In this Order the term "district" means a Superintendent Registrar's district, and the terms "existing district" and "existing sub-district" mean respectively a district and a sub-district which existed immediately before the 1st day of October, 1934.

2. That portion of the existing Salford district which will on the 1st day of October, 1934, become a separate district situate wholly without the County Borough of Salford shall be united with the existing district of Barton upon Irwell into one Superintendent Registrar's district and the district so formed shall be called the Barton district.

3.—(1) The Borough of Eccles, the Urban Districts of Irlam and Swinton and Pendlebury and those portions of the Urban Districts of Kearsley and Worsley situate in the existing Barton upon Irwell district shall together constitute a sub-district of the Barton district called the Eccles subdistrict.

(2) The Borough of Stretford and the Urban District of Urmston shall together constitute a sub-district of the Barton district called the Stretford sub-district.

(3) The existing Worsley sub-district shall cease to exist.

4. The Superintendent Registrar of the existing Barton upon Irwell district shall be the Superintendent Registrar of the Barton district as constituted by this Order.

5. The Registrars of Births and Deaths of the existing Barton and Stretford sub-districts shall respectively be the Registrars of Births and Deaths of the Eccles and Stretford sub-districts as constituted by this Order.

6. The functions under the Registration Acts in relation to the part of the existing Salford district which is situate without the County Borough of Salford are hereby transferred to the County Council of Lancaster.

## ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL IN ENGLAND.

## Dated 1st September, 1934.

Whereas parts of certain superintendent registrars' districts and of certain sub-districts which are situate partly within and partly without the County of Brecon will on the 1st day of October, 1934, in consequence of and by virtue of the Breconshire Registration Scheme, 1934, made by the Council of the County of Brecon and approved by the Minister of Health under Section 24 of the Local Government Act, 1929, become separate superintendent registrars' districts and sub-districts respectively situate wholly outside the said County; And whereas it is expedient that alterations should be made in certain of the said separate superintendent registrars' districts and in certain other contiguous superintendent registrars' districts, by the union or re-arrangement of certain of them and of the sub-districts comprised therein;

And whereas it is necessary to transfer the functions under the Registration Acts in relation to the parishes specified in the Schedule hereto:

Now, therefore, the Registrar-General of Births, Deaths and Marriages in England, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 10 and 11 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1837, Section 21 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, Section 21 (2) of the Local Government Act, 1929, and of all other powers in that behalf, with the approval and sanction of the Minister of Health, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Breconshire, Herefordshire and Monmouthshire Registration of Births, etc., Order, 1934, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October, 1934.

(2) In this Order the term "district" means a superintendent registrar's district, and the terms "existing district" and "existing sub-district" mean a district or sub-district which existed immediately before the 1st day of October, 1934.

2. The parishes specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto (being situate in the Counties specified in the second column thereof) shall be united with the districts specified in the third column thereof and shall be added to and form part of the subdistricts specified in the fourth column thereof.

3. The Beaufort sub-district in the Crickhowell superintendent registrar's district shall cease to exist.

4. The districts and the sub-districts extended under Article 2 of this Order shall be designated by the names respectively appearing in the third and fourth columns of the Schedule hereto.

5. The superintendent registrar and any registrar of marriages of any existing district with which another district is united by virtue of Article 2 of this Order shall respectively be the superintendent registrar or a registrar of marriages of the united district.

6. The registrar of any existing sub-district which is extended by this Order shall be the registrar of that sub-district as so extended.

7. The functions under the Registration Acts in relation to any parish specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto are hereby transferred to the Council of the County specified in the second column of the said Schedule.
