Notice is hereby given, in pursuance of Section 49 (3) of the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made the following Orders:—

Order No. 5250.

FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED
AREAS) ORDER OF 1934 (No. 34).

SUBJECT.

Declares the area described in the Schedule to be a Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925.

SCHEDULE.

An Area comprising:—

In the county of Southampton.

The city of Winchester.

The boroughs of Andover, Basingstoke, and Romsey.

The petty sessional divisions of Kingsclere, Winchester, Alresford, Basingstoke (*except the parishes of Mortimer West End, Silchester, Stratfield Saye, Stratfield Turgis, and Hartley Wespall*), Droxford (*except the parishes of Soberton, Hambledon, Denmead, Shedfield and Curdridge*), Eastleigh (*except the parishes of Millbrook, West End, Hedge End, Botley, Bursledon, Hound and Hamble*) and Andover (*except the parishes of South Tidworth, Kington, and Shipton Bellinger*).

The parishes of Broughton, Houghton, Buckholt, Kings Somborne, Bossington, East Tytherley, Mottisfont, Michelmersh, Ampfield, North Baddesley, East Meon, Froxfield, Colemore and Priors Dean, East Tisted, Newton Vallence, Farrington, Chawton, Alton, Medstead, Four Marks, Romsey Infra, Wield, Bentworth, Shalden, Lasham, South Warnborough, Greywell, so much of the parish of Froyle as lies to the north and west of the road from South Warnborough via Swaineshill Farm, Brockham Hill Farm, and Holybourne Church to Neatham, and so much of the parish of Romsey Extra as lies to the east of the railway which runs from Salisbury via Romsey and Nursling to Southampton.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

NORTH NORFOLK RIVERS CATCHMENT BOARD.

River Burn Drainage District.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming a Scheme submitted to him by the North Norfolk Rivers Catchment Board under Section 4 (1) (b) of the Act, making provision for the alteration of the boundaries of the River Burn Drainage District: and that the Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament, unless within thirty days from the date of this Notice a Memorial that the Order shall not become law without confirmation by Parliament is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected by the Order, and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a Memorial.
