REGULATIONS FOR THE COMPETITIVE SELECTION OF MALE ASSISTANT MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL ENGINEERS IN THE WORKS AND BUILDINGS DIRECTORATE OF THE AIR MINISTRY.

N.B.—These regulations are liable to alteration from time to time. Competitions do not take place at fixed intervals, but are held as occasion arises.

1. Candidates must have attained the age of 25 on a date to be fixed in respect of the competition in which they are to take part, but must not have attained 30 years of age on that date.
