FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1935 (No. 6).

#### SUBJECT.

Declares the Area described in the Schedule to be a Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of

### SCHEDULE.

An Area comprising: -

In the county of Lanark.

The city of Glasgow.

The burghs of Airdrie, Hamilton, Rutherglen, Coatbridge and Motherwell and Wishaw.

The parishes of New Monkland, Shotts, Cadder, Old Monkland, Glasgow, Bothwell, Cambuslang, Carmunnock, Blantyre, Rutherglan, Hamilton, East Kilbride, Glasford, Dalserf, Stonehouse, Dalziel, and so much of the parish of Cambusnethan as lies to the north and west of the following boundary, namely:—commencing at the point where the North British Railway line crosses the parish boundary at Wellhill; thence following the said railway line in a generally south-westerly direction to the point where it meets the road running from Wishaw via Waterloo to Carluke; thence south-east along the said road to the parish boundary.

In the county of Renfrew.

The burghs of Paisley, Johnstone, Barrhead, Renfrew and Pollokshaws.

The parishes of Erskine, Houston, Inchinnan, Renfrew, Kilbarchan, Neilston, Paisley, Mearns, Cathcart and Eaglesham.

In the county of Dunbarton.

The burghs of Kirkintilloch, Dumbarton, Clydebank and Milngavie.

The parishes of Dumbarton, Old Kilpatrick, New Kilpatrick, Kirkintilloch, Cumbernauld and so much of the parish of Kilmaronock as lies to the south of the Forth and Clyde Branch of the North British Railway line running from Balfron Station to Jamestown.

In the county of Stirling.

The burghs of Denny and Dunipace, and Kilsyth.

The parishes of Balfron, Killearn, Fintry, Denny, Kilsyth, Campsie, Strathblane, Baldernock and so much of the parish of Drymen as lies to the south of the Forth and Clyde Branch of the North British Railway line running from Balfron Station to Drymen Station.
