

## RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT,  
1924.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that he proposes after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 10 of the aforesaid London Traffic Act to make the London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (No. ) (Great West Road, Brentford) Regulations, 1935, in regard to a scheme of "one-way" traffic working along the duplicate carriageways of Great West Road (A.4) between Boston Road and Syon Lane, Brentford, Middlesex.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1934.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

RIVER RODING CATCHMENT BOARD.

*East Ham and Ilford Bridge to Ongar and Canfield Internal Drainage Districts.*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming the scheme submitted to him by the River Roding Catchment Board under Section 4 (1) (b) of that Act, making provision for the abolition or abrogation of the powers of certain existing Drainage Authorities; the constitution of the East Ham and the Ilford Bridge to Ongar and Canfield Internal Drainage Districts; and matters supplemental thereto; and that the Order will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament, unless within thirty-one days from the date of this Notice a Memorial that the Order shall not become law without confirmation by Parliament is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected by the Order and having an interest sufficient for the presentation of a Memorial.

A copy of the sealed Order has been deposited, together with a copy of the Scheme, as amended, and of the maps referred to in the Order, at the Offices of the Clerk of the Catchment Board, S. A. Legg, Esquire, National Provincial Bank Chambers, Romford, Essex, for public inspection for a period of thirty-one days from the date of this notice, and may be inspected during the ordinary hours of business.
